General Information

Purpose

This ride began with the express goal of honoring Mac Lawton. A committed follower of Jesus Christ, Mac has shown us Jesus both before and during his ongoing battle with cancer. In light of Mac's commitment to young people, all registration fees will go to (1) **The 567 Club** — a Christian club founded by Mac to mentor male youth, and (2) **Hope Unlimited** — a missions organization committed to the physical, educational, and spiritual needs of Brazil's street children. This is why we ride — so that young people may know Jesus and realize that someone cares for them!

Where

MAC's ride will begin at Easley First Baptist Church, 300 East Avenue, Easley, SC 29640. Please proceed to the parking lot located at the back of the church. When you arrive, please find the tent for Rider Packet Pick-up or Late Registration. These locations will provide you with more specific information.

When

September 6, 2008. Registration packets may be picked up between 6:30am and 7:00am. Late registration will be provided until 7:15am on race day for a fee of \$35.00. MAC's ride will begin at 7:30am.

What to expect

MAC's ride will support all levels of riders. The ultimate goal is to cycle from Easley to the top of Caesar's Head and back for a total of 62 miles. There will also be stop at 5 miles for our beginners to take a break and return for a 10 mile day of fun. For our intermediate riders we will have SAG (Support Aid Group) stations at 10 miles, 20 miles, and 31 miles. Mechanical support will be provided by **THE GREAT ESCAPE**. The bike route will be marked every mile and at each intersection. A map and emergency contact information will be provided in your registration packet on race day.
