

ANNUAL CODE OF CONDUCT CONTRACT  
Easley First Baptist Church Scouting Program

Membership in Easley First Baptist's Scouting Program is open to all youth who meet the specific membership requirements to join the Boy Scouts of America.

Additionally, the following Code of Conduct Rules will be mandated for all scouts:

- (1) Abide by the values expressed in the BSA Scouting Program Materials.
- (2) Recognition of God as the highest power, regardless of your religious faith.
- (3) Demonstrate behavior which exemplifies the highest level of good conduct and respect for others and is consistent at all times with the values expressed in Scouting (Promise, Oath, Law and Ideals).
- (4) Listen and pay attention to others at all times. Foul language (cursing) will not be tolerated at any time.
- (5) Physical – or – Verbal Abuse of other Scouts is not acceptable.
- (6) Roughhousing, fighting or "threats" to Scouts by other Scouts will not be allowed.
- (7) Each Scout will respect other Scout's property at all times.
- (8) Nothing will be taken or used which belongs to another Scout without specific permission from Scout.
- (9) If you break another Scout's property, you will pay for it – if you had permission or not.
- (10) During the meetings, Scouts will not be allowed to leave meeting areas for any reason, unless an Adult Leader has granted permission, and the proper supervision. This includes leaving with a parent.
- (11) The meeting area will be kept neat and left clean – including bathrooms.
- (12) Scouts will wear either Scout Uniform as directed by the Unit at every meeting, unless otherwise advised by Unit Leader(s).
- (13) We will strive to work as a TEAM at all times.

Non-compliance with any of the above Code rules will result in the Scout facing one or more of the following actions:

- ⌚ Apology to the offended individual(s).
- ⌚ Written reflection on the point of Scouting which was not followed.
- ⌚ Assigned additional tasks.
- ⌚ Removal from activity or not allowed participation in future activity.
- ⌚ Meeting with Unit Leader(s), Committee or other adult leader(s).
- ⌚ Peer to Peer Meeting with another Scout and Unit Leader(s).
- ⌚ Scout's parent(s) requested to begin attending Unit events.
- ⌚ Scout and parent(s) present themselves before the Unit Leader(s) and/or Committee.

- ⌚ Removal from leadership position.
- ⌚ Suspension and/or termination from Unit.
